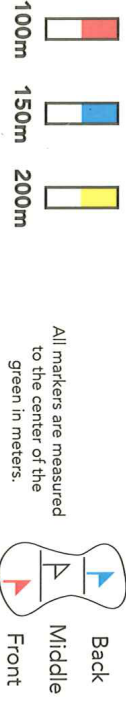

**ETIQUETTES & RULES**

- Kindly speed up play. When slow, allow others to pass through.
- Repair divots, ball marks and rake bunkers.
- Do not litter, bins are provided on the course.
- No Buggy allowed beyond roped areas.

**SIREN SIGNALS**

1. DISCONTINUE PLAY - Series of 20 seconds blast
2. RESUME PLAY - Series of 5 seconds blast
3. ABANDON PLAY - Long blast of 60 seconds

**LOCAL RULES**

The game of golf must be played in accordance with the Rules of golf issued by R&A Rules Ltd. and the Local Rules of KDE.

- 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)** is indicated by white stakes and/or lines. Where both stakes and lines exist, the line defines the out of bounds.
- 2. Water Hazards (Rule 26-1)** are indicated by yellow stakes and/or lines. Lateral water hazards are indicated by red stakes and/or finses. The hazards on Hole 3, 4, 6 and 1 extend to the boundary of the course.
- 3. Lateral water hazard on Hole 3 and Hole 8**  
The player may under penalty of one stroke, drop a ball within 2 club length of the nearest point on the fairway edge of the adjacent buggy track which is not nearer the hole than the spot where the ball last crossed the hazard margin.
- 4. Ground under Repair (Rule 25-1)**
  - a. Areas bounded by white lines.
  - b. Areas damaged by animal action.
- 5. Movable Obstructions (Rule 24-1)**
  - a. Stones in bunkers, c. Distance markers.
  - b. Yellow chains or ropes in the course.
- 6. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)**
  - a. Buggy tracks including surrounding drains.
  - b. Lighting post and electrical boxes.
  - c. Sprinkler heads and irrigation boxes.
  - d. Halfway hut and rain shelters.
  - e. Young trees identified by stakes.
  - f. Stakes supporting trees.
  - g. Drainage grills.
  - h. Sand boxes.
  - i. Hazards stakes.
- 7. Integral Parts of the Course**
  - a. Flower beds.
- 8. Drop Zones - Hole 3** An unplayable ball in the area left of the green may, as an additional option, be dropped under penalty of one stroke in the nearest drop zone.
- 9. Embedded ball through the green**  
Through the green, a ball which is embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.  
**Exception:** A player may not obtain relief under this local rule if it is clearly unreasonable for him to play a stroke because of interference by anything other the condition covered by this Local Rule.

**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:**

- Match Play - Loss of Hole
- Strokeplay - Two Strokes
